

/14 Polaroid Polaroid cameras were never produced in Japan, and have a separate release date. Polaroid OQ100 Sold between 1976 and 1979, the OQ100 was a rangefinder style camera, available in black and white and color. Polaroid 6263 Polaroid released the 6263 in 1981. The camera was manufactured by Nishika Film with the manufacturing facilities in Tokyo and Osaka. The camera was the first camera produced after Polaroid announced the discontinuation of its instant film product line. This was also the first Polaroid camera produced in the U.S. The initial photography was made possible by the introduction of a new film format that was compatible with 120 format cameras. Like the OQ100, the camera was available in black and white and color. Unlike its predecessor, the camera was shipped with a folding viewfinder. The top of the camera was silver with the folding viewfinder and the body was black with a red shutter button and a polaroid logo.
